Likewise, through positive relationships, our programs respect and support the ideals, cultures, and values of families in their task of nurturing children and youth. SCHOOL AGE CARE

School Age Care (SAC) programs provide quality out-of-school activities for children in kindergarten through 12 years old. Our programs are designed to enhance rather than duplicate the school day, and we work with dynamic organizations such as the Boys & Girls Clubs of America and 4-H to offer the best programming. Programs vary by installation, so check with your local installation for details.

Youth ages 5 (and in kindergarten) through 12 (and in 6th grade) are able to utilize our School Aged Care (SAC). We serve over 10 Elementary and Middle Schools.

We participate in Passport to Manhood,
Smart Girls, Torch Club, 4H,
Anchored4Life, and a variety of other
curriculums that help us cultivate
experiential learning experiences for our
youth. Youth are offered opportunities
to develop in Health & Wellness,
Education and STEM, Performing,
Applied and Digital Arts, Leadership &
Service as well as Sports & Recreation.

Before-school and after-school programs are available, as well as Seasonal Camps.

TEEN INFORMATION

The Youth Center offers a time for teens every evening from 2:00pm – 6:00pm to socialize with other teens through art projects, culinary classes, gardening, video games (rated Teens Xbox, PlayStation and Nintendo), and more.

The Youth Center provides opportunities for teen volunteerism in programs such as the Leaders in Training and Jr.

Program Assistant program, service project opportunities, and some grantfunded employment opportunities.

Teens may take part in Job Ready night, Career Launch and Goals for Graduation, all providing training and possible scholarship opportunities.
